A teleconference was held at 2: 00 PM Eastern Time (USA) for selection of the Regional Championship shows for 2009. The selection is as follows:

- Region 1: California Saddle Horse Futurity Horse Show-September 10-12 (tentative)
Arizona Futurity-October 23-29
These were the only applicants from this region.
- Region 2: NWSA Fall Classic & Futurity Horse Show-September 25-26
This was the only applicant from this region.
- Region 3/4: Wisconsin Futurity Horse Show, September 16-20
This was the only applicant for this region.
- Region 5: Mid-America Mane Event, October 22-26
Also applying for this region were St. Louis National Charity and Colorado Fall Charity. Discussion of each of the shows and all were in agreement to have Mid-America Mane Event have the Regional Championship for one

more year as 2008 is their first year to host, and then reconsider moving again next year.

-Region 6/7: State Fair of Texas

They sent a tentative application as they want to see how it goes this year. This is their first year as they had to get the show licensed by USEF.

Region 8: All American Horse Show-September 8-12
This was the only applicant from this region.

Region 9: North Carolina State Fair Horse Show-October 21-24
This was the only show from the region but three different applications recommending the show.

Region 10: Southeastern Charity Horse Show-September 19-22
This was the only applicant from this region.

Region 11: ASHAV Horse Show-September 25-28
Also applying for this region was Pennsylvania National Charity. All were in agreement, that it is time for ASHAV to host the Regional Championship. All were in agreement that it could rotate back to Pennsylvania National.

INTERNATIONAL: Alan gave the background on international shows applying and that we are just not ready to sanction such competitions abroad, for many reasons. The reasons for developing Regional Championships in the United States do not really apply internationally, at least at this time. All were in agreement that we contact the international shows by letter stating this.

With no further business to come before the meeting, it was adjourned by consent of all attendees at approximately 3 p.m.
